

PRIVACY POLICY ABOUT PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Pursuant to Article 13 UE Regulation 2016/679 (hereafter called "Regulation"), this page describes the methods for personal data processing of users who consult the website of Nuova Inoxtecnica srl, accessible by web address <http://www.nuovainoxtecnica.com>.

CONTROLLER RESPONSIBLE FOR DATA PROCESSING

TYPES OF PROCESSED DATA AND PROCESSING PURPOSES

During the consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable natural persons, such as navigation data and data entered by the user, may be processed.

Navigation data - The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of users' computers and terminals, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numeric code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's IT environment.

The navigation data does not persist for more than seven days (except for any need to investigate crimes by the Judicial Authority).

Data provided by the user - The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of messages to the contact address of Nuova Inoxtecnica srl, as well as the compilation and submission of the form on the site for contact request, involve the acquisition of data contact details of the sender, necessary to respond, as well as any personal data that may be included in the communications.

Cookies and other tracking systems - No technical, analytical or user profiling cookies are used on this site, nor are other tracking methods used.

LEGAL BASIS FOR DATA PROCESSING

The personal data indicated on this page are processed by Nuova Inoxtecnica srl on the basis of the underlying agreement, between site visitors and the Data Controller, to supply information following a free request or visit to the site.

DATA ADDRESSEES

The personal data collected through this site are processed exclusively by the specifically authorized staff of Nuova Inoxtecnica srl and are not communicated to external third parties.

RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

The GDPR provisions (articles from 15 to 22) recognizes important rights regarding the protection of personal data, which can be exercised by contacting the data controller using the above contact details.

Access to personal data - The interested party has the right to know if its personal data are being treated and, if confirmed, to obtain a copy of such data and be informed about the following: data origin; data recipients; data processing purposes; presence or not of an automated decision-making process, including profiling; data retention time; rights foreseen by EU Regulation 679/2016.

Data rectification, cancellation, processing limitation, portability of personal data - The interested party may request, in the cases foreseen by the Regulations, that its personal data are rectified or deleted, or that their processing is limited. He can also request that the data provided to the data controller can be transferred to another controller ("right to portability"), in the event that the data processing is based on his consent or on a contract stipulated with him and is carried out by automated means.

Opposition to data processing - The interested party may oppose the processing of his personal data for reasons related to his particular situation, to be specified in the request; or without the need to justify the opposition, when his data are processed for direct marketing purposes.

CLAIM RIGHTS

To exercise the above mentioned rights, the interested party may submit, free of charge and without particular formalities, a request to exercise its rights to the data controller (a facsimile form is available on the website www.garanteprivacy.it). He will receive an answer within time and manner established by the legislation. If he doesn't receive an answer within the indicated time frame or does not consider it satisfactory, the interested party may contact the Guarantor for the protection of personal data, by means of a complaint pursuant to art. 77 of the Regulations, or to the judicial authority.
